## Florida Atlantic University

## Regulation 4.012 Student Financial Aid

- (1) <u>General Information</u> Florida Atlantic University offers a variety of financialid programs including grants, scholarships, loans and tipate temployment to helptudents meet educational expenses. Assistance is provided in compliance with feated at tate regulations, in a manner that serves the University's plan for equalizational opportunity.
  - (A) All financial assistance programs are administered by the Student Financial Office in accordance with a nationally accepted policy that the family, meaning parents, student, and spouse (if applicable), is responsible for the student's educational expenses. Financial need for aid programs is established by a comparison of the totaleducational cost (budget) with the expected family contribution. A financial aid committee shall be constituted by the Director of Student Financial Aido recommend bliversity policy on matters relating to financial aid, recommend specific financial aid program objectives in stuppor the University master plarand facilitate the conduct of financial aid activities.
  - (B) The FAU Office of Institutional Effectiveness and Analysis shall coordinate the collection of data for all programs of financial aid.
  - (C) Financial aid is awarded on the basis of greatest financial need randademic merit and availability of funds Priority is given to those students who apply by the priority deadline of January for the following academic year. Awards for late applicants are contingent upon the vailability of student aid funds. The FAU financial aid program is administered with orate to race, creed, color, gender sexual orientation physical handicap or national origin.
  - (D) Students may be eligible for a short term and be beginning the first week of each semester. To be considered, students must complete an application and meet all published eligibility criteria.
- (2) <u>Application ProceduresStudent aid applicants must complete the steps lisetow,</u> before an aid offecan be made to them:
  - (A) Complete the Free Application for Federa Student Aid FAFS Agov) with FAU's school code (00148.1)
  - (B) Apply for admission to the University and be accepted as a degeteing student. Qualifying student in FAU's Comprehensive Transition gram (Academy for Community Inclusion) may be eligible for financial aid without being accepted to a degree-king program.

- (C) Monitor FAU email and student account for notifications of missing documentation and followinstructions for submission.
- (D) If selected for verification students must submit all documents requested by the Office of Student Finanial Aid in order to resolve any inconsistencies in the application information.

## (3) Offers of Financial Aid

- (A) For continuing students, financial aid offers flow fall semester are made prior to the beginning of the fall semester. Spring and summer financial aid offers are made available to continuing students after registration opens for the applicable term. Continuing students must register for at least ones the fore offers are made. Financial aid offers for the upcoming fall term may be made to First Time in College freshman as early as December of the previous academic year.
- (B) Loan offers and some grant/scholarship offers must be accepted through the University online portal to be processed.
- (C) Students must reapply for most financial aid programs annually. To remain eligible for assistance at FAId, student must be eligible foontinued enrollment at the University, taking courses which are applicable to the gree program, making measurable academic progress cinfemheabh 5.1 (s) (0)1 (l)-1 (lva)-1 (e)

- (B) Students who participate in a concurrent enrollment program with an eligible community or state college must be enrolled for a minimum of six credits at Florida Atlantic University during that term in order to be eligible to receive financial aid from FAUInstitutional financial aid, however, may not be disbursed based on concurrent enrollededits. Exceptions may be made whenan enrollment certification is received from the host institution and overall minimum half-time status is verified. Inaddition, the FAUconcurrent enrollment form, accompanied by all required documents as indicated on the fourst, be submitted to the FAU Student Financial Antifice.
- (5) <u>Satisfactory Academic Progress</u>. In order to be eligible to receive financialized, Federal regulations require that students must demonstrate satisfactory academics in their selected course of study according to standards described in Uthineersity's policy. These standards include qualitative (grade point average) causantitative (number of credit hours) requirements as well as a maximum time framember of attempted or the hours) allowed to complete a degree he Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy is available on the FAU Financial Aid website.
- (6) <u>Financial Aid Appeals</u>Petitions for review of decisions made by the Studfantancial Aid Office must be submitted in writignwith attached supporting cumentation. Requests may be made for the review of financial aid offered and deview of termination from financial aid due to lack of satisfactory academic progressification of the petition outcome is made by e mail.
